"Downtown review board will have to OK future Veterans Memorial Arena signs"

"Signs advertising Hunt, Green & James law firm have been removed from Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena"

"Signs of the building's name are still OK.

So, too, are the awning and directional signs that adorn the Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena.

But outside advertisements — like those for the Hunt, Green & James law firm — $\operatorname{aren't}$ legal.

And according to a bill passed Tuesday night by City Council, anything else that will be affixed to the exterior of the city-owned structure will have to adhere to Downtown design standards and be approved by the Downtown Development Review Board.

The council bill puts those rules into place almost a week after city attorneys said the exterior advertising by the local law firm violated the city's charter and state laws.

The firm in September signed a \$300,000 sponsorship agreement with SMG, which runs the city's venues.

The deal was later amended to allow window advertising on all four sides of the arena.

City law, though, said exterior signage had to advertise products, activities or services associated with the facility.

Council could amend the charter to change those signage regulations, but state law also was violated when the firm's advertisements on the north side of the building weren't far enough away from the highway.

Overall, the signage led to pushback from those who oppose billboards and from other scenic groups, with council member Bill Bishop introducing legislation in late January to remedy the situation...

Digital sign content control:

"FBI investigating after pornographic image appears on billboard"

"It's a big electronic advertisement familiar to anyone who travels the intersection of Peachtree Road and East Paces Ferry in Buckhead.

...among the images, drivers saw a graphic picture of a man exposing himself.

One driver was so disturbed she called 911.

'There's an electronic billboard that is flashing a naked man, one woman said in the 911 call. It's not actually an emergency; it's just totally disgusting.'

Police say the billboard's owner temporarily cut power to the billboard.

The comments I was seeing on it was 'Oh my gosh! The children,' said Buckhead resident Allison. Allison said she saw the image on social media.

'I know people from the pizza place were sitting and having to see it while they ate', Allison said.

Wednesday, an FBI spokesperson told Viteri that agents are trying to determine all of the servers involved in the apparent hacking and their locations.

The president of Georgia's Outdoor Advertising Association sent Viteri a statement saying, 'The industry has established clear and strict protocols on security to prevent hacking of digital billboards.'
